YIELDING TO AUTHORITY

Being obedient

“Let every soul be subject to the governing authorities. For there is no authority except from God, and the authorities that exist are appointed by God. Therefore whoever resists the authority resists the ordinance of God, and those who resist will bring judgment on themselves.”
Romans 13:1

“If you are willing and obedient, you shall eat the good of the land; but if you refuse and rebel, you shall be devoured by the sword; for the mouth of the Lord has spoken.” Isaiah 1:19-20

From early childhood we are told what to do and when to do it. We are naturally resistant to being told what to do and become rebellious and dis-obedient. By our parents we were told to clean our room, eat all our vegetables, take the trash out, when to bathe, when go to bed, and when to get up; and the list goes on. Even at a very young age there were consequences for our disobedience. By the consequences of our resistance, we learned to follow the direction of our parents. Authority does not stop there. At school we found that there were people everywhere telling us what to do. We were told to be quiet, to listen, and to pay attention, to do homework assignments, and participate in class, there were no excuses for tardiness. Again

there were consequences for not adhering to authority; such as verbal warnings, standing in the corner, detention, and even suspension. Our disobedience caused us to be disciplined at home as well. The most dreaded punishment, “you’re grounded!” once more, by our disobedience we learned to respect authority and be obedient.

After graduation from high school we found that there were still more authority figures telling us what to do. By this time, hopefully, we were able to accept and respect authority figures in the work place, driving on the highways and byways and obeying the laws of the land. Consequences for disobedience still applied. Fighting against authority in the work place could mean unemployment, resisting the rules of the road might mean loss of driving privileges, resisting the laws of the land would surely mean incarceration where once again and at a higher level there was authority.

Who among us has been in situations of the consequences caused by our own disobedience? Is it not true that all of us have experienced the wrath of authority throughout our lives? What do we learn from all of this? We learn to respect authority and be obedient.
